



# DOMAINE DU PONT DE BREUX

## L'IMPOULSIF POULSARD

Domaine du Pont de Breux is located north of the "Côtes du Jura" appellation with parcels of vines in Marnoz and Salins-les-Bains. The estate was created in 1991 with the current owner Emilie Gérard taking over in 2015. Although the property is around 16ha in size, only 4ha is planted with vines, with the rest left for cattle to graze on.

Poulsard is the famous thin skinned grape almost exclusively found only in the Jura region. It produces wines light in colour but big on red fruit flavours. Many of the wines made from Poulsard will have a reductive stink to them when first opened, but more often than not, the reduction blows off to reveal the fruit underneath. This wine has only a 'kiss off reduction' and benefits from a big glass or a decant.
