The Vernambaud is a vineyard next to the village of Grusse, a few km's north-east of Rotalier. Lovers of Jura unicorn wines may recognize the slope as it is also home to the vines of Kenjiro Kagami of Domaine des Miroirs.

WINEMAKING

Spontaneous fermentation, hand harvested, 100% destemmed. 228L used burgundy barrels for elevage. Henri buys barrels that have had 2-3 uses before and stops using them after 8 wines. No additions other than SO₂, small amounts after fermentations and before bottling. Never chaptalized.

Malolactic: Yes

Fining: No (although Henri uses bentonite on some occasions)

Filtration: Light filtration

Total Acidity: 4.3g/L (H₂SO₄)

PH: 3.21

Free SO₂: 6mg/L

Total SO₂: 67mg/L

Alcohol: 11.5% ABV

Satellite view, the top vineyard is the Miroirs (Entre Deux Bleus) and the lower vineyard is Henri's. Both have the same exposition, blue marl and forest surrounding them.
